
A Partnership for Student Success

Drawing from past success with local school districts, the enhanced MTDA Connect Credit Recovery program will continue to deliver high quality curriculum and academic coaches to support student success.



The Design

As you can see by the graphic on the right, the enhanced MTDA Connect Credit Recovery is very similar to the program that has existed the past four years. Formalizing the Local Support role is the major enhancement to the program moving forward. The Local Support person is identified as the adult working directly with recovery student. This may be the same person that you have identified as your site facilitator in the past or this may be someone that has helped out in a lab with students but did not have a formally identified role. We know that many districts have had a teacher, counselor, or paraprofessional working in lab environments with credit recovery students. In the enhanced program, we will ask that the local support person is identified so we can provide clear communication as to how the student is progressing through the MTDA Connect Credit Recovery program. MTDA will continue to rely on Site Facilitators for enrollment and local oversight of the partnership between the local district and MTDA.
